

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

First Reconciliation + First Communion



The Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is part of a two year journey, typically beginning when a child enters the first grade. In order to participate in these Sacraments, a child must be Baptized in a Roman Catholic Church prior to the age of 8 years old. The Sacrament of Reconciliation must be completed before the Sacrament of First Holy Communion.

In order to prepare and understand these Sacraments more fully, children in the Sacramental Preparation program will be required to be enrolled in faith formation class at SSJ or attend the SSJ Catholic school. Additionally, children will need to attend four Sacrament Preparation workshops with a parent or adult. One parent is required to attend and be active participants with their child(ren) at all of these meetings. If you are unable to attend one of these meetings, you will need to contact Rhea Moreno for a make-up session.
